Inumbra provides protection with a minimalist look and no technical parts on view. Opens and closes easily with a separate handle. Inumbra has been submitted to wind-tunnel testing at the Von

Karman Institute. Although the parasol can withstand wind speeds of up to 8 on the Beaufort scale, it is of course advisable to close it sooner (from wind speed 6 as a rule of thumb).

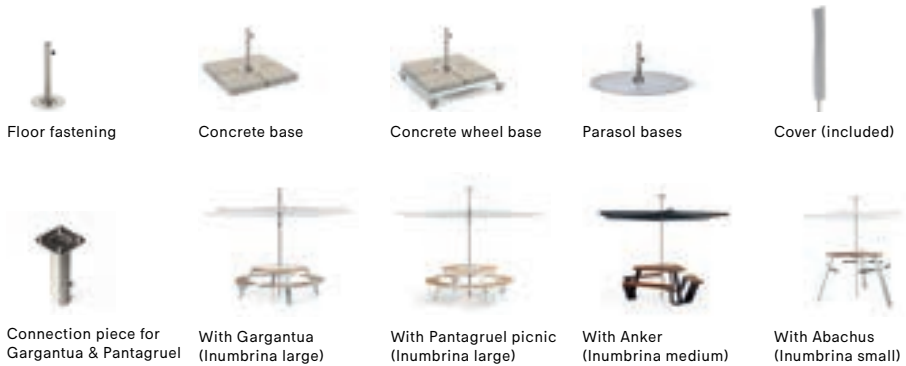
The major difference between Inumbrina and Inumbrina lies in how they are operated. When converting to a thinner and lighter central pole, the challenge was to replace the handle and spindle sys-

tem. Our technical team came up with an ingenious pulley and rope system. Opening and closing the parasol with a rope turns out to be really easy, and even faster!
